



The surface of screen is processed to achieve good performance of the reflector. Any damage of surface will influence projection effects so please use this product in right way.


Caution

 Please contact your local dealer for repairing and replacing. Please contact us if you have any questions. Avoid taking apart the fixture yourself.










Open Screen

1. Put the screen on the ground, in a proper position facing the projector. Turn the feet out until they are perpendicular to the screen casing (Figure 1 - 2).



2. Pull up the handle while using the thumb to release the tube lock as arrow indicates (Figure 3).



3. Opening the screen, if the support bar can not be expanded completely, please use screwdriver to adjust the screws until support bar can be expanded completely.



4. The support bars will have some connecting separations after used in many time. Please follow the pictures to reconnect.



Open Screen

5. Pull up the screen with constant speed and stop at desired position for three minutes so that the screen can be installed (Figure 6 - 9).







6. Adjust the foot wheel when the ground is not even. To be exact, clockwise rotation raises the foot while counterclockwise rotation lowers the foot, with limits of five circles or within 8mm (Figure 10 - 11).



Retract screen

- 1. Put the screen back to casing after using.
- 2. Hold the handle and press it down slowly (Figure 12). According to Figure 13, Please stay the support levers into the seats for locking easily(Figure 14). When you can hear "pa", it means that the screen is locked (Figure 15).


